Thank you for affording the University the opportunity to address your staff's questions and concerns regarding the draft 2005 Campus Master Plan Stadium Amendment. We appreciate your helpful comments and look forward to working with you in the future.

The following is our response to your request for additional information regarding reclaimed water:

The university shall adhere to the rules set forth in the Florida Administrative Code regarding the use of reclaimed water. In addition, the university plans to use reclaimed water campus wide by the year 2007. Policy 1.3.5 of the Campus Master Plan states: The University shall seek out every opportunity to prioritize the use of storm water as follows:

1. Irrigation from existing storm water ponds
2. Reclaimed water from the Iron Bridge
3. Ground water usage needs to be minimized or eliminated

It is our understanding that your staff's questions and comments have been addressed. However, if you have further questions, please do not hesitate to call me at (407)823-2166. Again, we thank you for your input regarding the draft amendment to the Campus Master Plan. The adoption public hearing with the UCF Board of Trustees is scheduled for November 9, 2005.
